

DAVIS, HENRY CLARKE

EARLY LIFE

Apr 1, 1887

Born in Schomberg, Ontario to Walter James and Elizabeth (Clarke) Davis. He was the older brother of *Daniel Irwin Davis*.

Jan 18, 1916

Age 28

Admitted to Moore Barracks Canadian Hospital, Shorncliffe, England because he was suspected of having meningitis. He was discharged from the hospital 3 days later.

Jul 12, 1919

Age 32

Major Henry Davis was discharged because of general demobilization. He served in England and France with C.A.M.C.

Age 33

Married Lucy Montague Bate, daughter of Thomas Ezra and Arabella (Dixon) Bate.

1930 US Census

Age 43

Rented at 14 Green Street, San Francisco, California, United States. Henry worked as a doctor at St. Francis Hospital in San Francisco, California.

Feb 28, 1952

Age 64

Henry died in San Francisco, California.
