## EARLY LIFE

**Mar 16, 1889**

Born in King Township, Ontario to George McGiven and Ellen (Hughes) Eadie.

**1901 Census**

Age 12

Lived in Toronto, Ontario with Georgie Eadie (head of house – father, age 57), Ellen Eadie (mother, age 54), William Eadie (brother, age 35), John Eadie (brother, age 25), Samuel Eadie (brother, age 23), Mabel Eadie (sister, age 18), Thomas Eadie (brother, age 16), Florence Eadie (sister, age 14) and Annie Ferguson (lodger, age 21).

**Apr 11, 1911**

Age 21

Went to Detroit, Michigan, United States to visit his brother Thomas Eadie who lived at 164 High Street West in Detroit.

**Jun 24, 1914**

Age 25

Married Pearl May Stoneman (age 22), daughter of Joseph Thomas and Hannah (Ducker) Stoneman.

Lived at 36 Laughton, High Park, Toronto with Pearl Eadie (wife) and his widowed mother-in-law Hannah Stoneman.

### 1949 Voter List

Age 60

At age 60, Louis Eadie lived at 83 Evans Avenue, High Park, Toronto with his wife Pearl Eadie. Louis Eadie worked as a surveyor.

### 1957 Voter List

Age 68

Retired from being a city planner and lived at 83 Evans Avenue, High Park, Toronto with Pearl Eadie (wife).

### 1968 Voter List

Age 79

Lived at 404 Weston Road, York, Ontario with his wife Pearl Eadie.

### Nov 28, 1974

Age 85

Louis Francis Eadie died at the Oak Ridge Villa Nursing Home. He is buried at Prospect Cemetery in Toronto, Ontario.
