## EARLY LIFE

**Jan 4, 1897**

Born in King City, Ontario to Thomas and Lilian Albina (Worthington) Johnson.

**1901 Census**

Age 4

Lived in King, Ontario with Thomas Johnson (head of house – father, age 34), Lilian Johnson (mother, age 38) and Henry Johnson (brother, age 1).

**1906 Census**

Age 9

Lived in Alberta with Thomas Johnson (head of house – father, age 40), Lilian Johnson (mother, age 43), Henry Johnson (brother, age 6) and Benjamin Johnson (brother, age 4).

**1911 Census**

Age 14

Lived in MacLeod, Alberta with Thomas Johnson (head of house – father, age 45), Lilian Johnson (mother, age 48), Henry Johnson (brother, age 11) and Benjamin Johnson (brother, age 9).

**1916 Census**

Age 19

Lived in MacLeod, Alberta with Thomas Johnson (head of house – father, age 50), Lilian Johnson (mother, age 53), Henry Johnson (brother, age 17), Benjamin Johnson (brother, age 15), Henry Pickering (boarder, age 40) and Katherine Pickering (boarder, age 40).
