Oct 4, 1894

Born in Aurora, Ontario to George and Janet (Holt) Patrick. He was the younger brother of *Arthur Alpheus Patrick*.

Married Hannah Renshaw (age 19), daughter of Thomas and Mary Renshaw of England. At the time of the wedding Robert worked as a teamster. They had 8 children together: Robert, Audrey, Helen, Jack, Jean, Joan, Donald and Ronald Patrick.

May 24, 1953

Age 56

Robert died at Sunnybrook Hospital in Toronto, Ontario. He is buried at Resthaven Memorial Gardens in Scarborough, Ontario.
